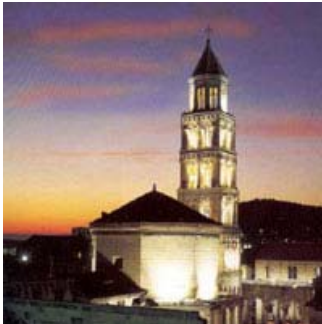

Sample Day-by-Day Itineraryⁱⁱⁱ

Day 1 - Depart USA

Depart from New York's JFK airport on your overnight flight to Dubrovnik. □

Day 2 - Arrive Dubrovnik

We will meet you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel. Afternoon is at leisure.

Day 3 - Dubrovnik

Morning walking tour of "Old Dubrovnik". We will visit the Franciscan Monastery, housing one of the world's oldest pharmacies; the old harbor; St. Laurence Fortress, the Sponza and Rector's Palaces; and other points of interest in this best preserved European walled city. The rest of the day is at leisure.

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Day 4 - Dubrovnik - Split

Depart Dubrovnik and travel north along the spectacular Adriatic coast, past old fishing villages and new resorts, to Split. Enjoy a city tour featuring the historic inner city, built around the Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace, a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. See the remnants of Split's Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter's Temple, the Peristyle and the Cathedral.

Day 5 - Split - Trogir - Zadar - Plitvice Lakes

After breakfast, head to Trogir, the center of artistic activities. Scholars from around the world gather to study and paint here. Then, turn inland and travel to Plitvice Lakes National Park. Upon arrival, have your camera ready and take a walking tour around several of the lower lakes. Enjoy the breathtaking scenery of this natural wonder of 16 terraced lakes surrounded by thickly wooded mountains and lush vegetation.

Day 6 - Plitvice Lakes

A full day to enjoy the breathtaking scenery of this natural wonder of 16 terraced lakes, surrounded by thickly wooded mountains and lush vegetation. In the morning, there's a walking tour around several of the lower lakes. The rest of the day is at leisure.

Day 7 - Plitvice Lakes - Opatija - Postojna - Bled

Return to the coast and travel along the beautiful bay of Kvarner to its popular resort, Opatija. After some free time, journey north to Postojna, home to one of the largest caves in Europe. Tour the fantastic subterranean world by miniature electric train. Afterwards, continue to Bled, beautifully set amidst the Julian Alps.

Day 8 - Bled

A sightseeing tour of Bled features the charming town with the lakeshore, and imposing Bled Castle, perched on a cliff high above the lake. The balance of the day is at leisure for optional activities, such as visiting the small island in the middle of the lake.

Day 9 - Bled - Ljubljana- Zagreb

Start your day with a walking tour of Ljubljana, the capital of Slovenia. Visit the most significant sights of the old city centre: the picturesque Central open-air Market and the Three Bridges, both designed by famous architect Joze Plecnik, Baroque Town Hall and Robba's Fountain. Then, continue to Zagreb, the capital city of Croatia.

Day 10 - Zagreb

This morning, enjoy a city tour featuring the historic Upper Town, St. Mark's Church, St. Catherine's Church, the Cathedral, the Parliament and the Government Palace. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore the winding streets of the old town or take an optional excursion to the countryside.

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Day 11 - Zagreb - USA

After breakfast we drive to nearby Zagreb airport for your flights home.

Important Passport and Visa Information

Obtaining a passport is solely your responsibility. A Visa is not required for US Citizens or Nationals for the length of this tour.

If a minor is traveling with only one parent, it is recommended that you complete an Affidavit of Minor Travel. This form must be notarized. Some countries require the affidavit; if they do, you will not be allowed to board the aircraft without it. You may download the form:

Booking, Payment and Cancellation/Refund

Booking:

Ubiquity International can book this tour and travel insurance for you. Please note that for most transactions, UI has a non-refundable 5% agency fee per transaction. This fee does not apply to Travel Insurance.

To book, call us at 1.866.984.8687 or complete the enclosed registration form. Fax or mail it to us (see contact information at bottom of each page).

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Payment:

A \$400 per person deposit is due at the time of booking. The balance of your trips costs will be due 60 days prior to departure. Full cost must be paid if booked with 60 days of departure. Please note a late booking fee of \$50 will be added to reservations made with in 30 days of the departure date. UI asks that you allow extra time for processing.

Cancellation/Refund:

Please note that pilgrimage cancellation or refund is processed directly by 206 Tours. Once a partial/ deposit or full payment has been made, cancellations will only be accepted in writing. Cancellation terms will be applied based on the date that the written cancellation is received. In addition to a \$200 per person administration fee, the following charges apply if a cancellation is made before departure (per person of total tour price):

60 - 46 days prior to departure	10%
45 - 21 days prior to departure	50%
20 - 03 days prior to departure	80%
02 days prior to departure or no-show	no refund

Additionally, air tickets are normally not refundable.

Requests for a refund must be in writing (mail, fax or e-mail). Phone calls cannot be used as a form of cancellation. It is the individual's responsibility to confirm 206 Tours' receipt of cancellations regardless of their form. Refunds will be issued within 30 to 60 days of receipt and pending return of airline tickets and receipt of written notice of cancellation. Returned checks or ACH payments are subject to an administrative fee of \$30. Refunds for payments made by credit card are subject to an additional 3.5% fee. No changes of names or substitutions are permitted. No refund or cancellation fees will be waived due to death or sickness.
